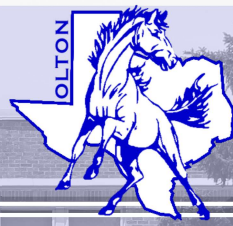

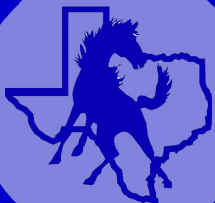

\$1.6 Million Proposed Bond

Olton ISD is asking voters to authorize \$1.6 million in bonds to fund improvements, equipment and other projects across the district

5 Years

Estimated Repayment Period

The new bond program will be structured with annual principal payments over a 5-year period. Olton ISD WILL receive State assistance from the EDA Program for the repayment of bonds beginning in year 2029/30

Projected Tax Impact



Projected Increase:
\$0.205 per \$100 of taxable
valuation starting with the
2027-2028 tax bill.

This is a property tax increase. The projected tax-rate impact shown in this brochure is based on the assumptions contained in the District's July 2026 preliminary tax-rate impact analysis.

	VATRE	BOND
Purpose	District Operations	Capital projects / equipment
Amount	Tax-rate authorization	\$1.6 million
Tax Mechanism	M&O (Maintenance & Operations)	I&S (Interest & Sinking Fund)
Proposed Impact	+\$0.0641 / \$100	+\$0.205 / \$100 projected (starting with the 27-28 tax bill)
Repayment	Annual operating revenue	5-year bond repayment
